Foreign Sports Fishing Ancillary Vessel License Terms and Conditions

Foreign sports fishing ancillary vessels will be permitted to fish inshore (only) for the enjoyment of visiting anglers and their families as follows:

- 1. Vessels will be permitted to fish inshore at the same time as the primary vessel is fishing offshore.
- 2. Vessels should be operated by a crew member of the primary vessel if possible but, in any event, should be operated by a responsible person at least 16 years old.
- 3. A Foreign Sports Fishing Ancillary Vessel License decal must be displayed on the starboard side of the ancillary vessel.
- 4. Vessels should adhere to a bag limit of 30 lbs of reef fish per day.
- 5. Ancillary vessels should not target or retain any of the protected fish species (see enclosed summary of Bermuda Marine Resources legislation).
- 6. Fish taken at sea that are regulated by a minimum size or a bag limit must be landed whole (see enclosed Bermuda Marine Resources Booklet).
- 7. A record of fish landings is encouraged (see enclosed recreational fishing logbook, which should be returned to the Department before departure from Bermuda).
